#### 2. FEES:

 a) \$12.00 per class or \$60.00 for unlimited classes per horse/handler for this day. *Early bird registration for current ADMC members \$30!* – Register and pay by May 15.

- 5. EQUINES: Age of equine shall be that reached during the calendar year 2024. All equines welcome! Stallions/Jacks not to be handled by anyone under 18. Must be in a chain and under control at all times. If this is not the case, they will be asked to leave the premises without refund.

#### 6. EXHIBITORS:

a) Age as of January 1, 2024

The same animal can be show by different handlers in different age categories

- b) Well-behaved dogs must remain on a leash and supervised at all times.
- c) No bleachers, bring your own lawn chairs.
- 7. HELMETS: Are encouraged and will never be penalized. All youth exhibitors must have properly fitted and certified helmets on when riding or working with livestock.

#### 8. RULES:

- a) Have FUN and be SAFE
- b) ADMC, the Show Committee and Rich Valley Ag Society will not be responsible for any loss, damage or injury to persons, equine, or property at this show.
- c) All classes are at the decision of the Judge. Some classes may be merged together to help the show run along. Classes may change based on participation numbers
- d) Show clothes not required. Training equipment allowed. Two hands welcome in all classes.
- e) No cross entry between walk trot and regular classes.

#### 9. DESCRIPTIONS:

- a) <u>HALTER CLASSES</u> Any aged handler. Competitors may show more than one horse in a class provided they have people to hold the other horses.
- b) <u>SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES</u> Patterns will be posted online at least a week before show date
- <u>PLEASURE CLASSES</u> English or Western, each entry will be judged according to riding style and breed standard.
- d) <u>TOILET PAPER PAIRS</u> Pairs will be required to follow the judge's instructions while holding on to the ends of a length of toilet paper. You will be eliminated if your toilet paper breaks. If you do not have a partner but would like to enter this class, we will attempt to find a partner for you.
- e) COSTUME CLASS Open to all ages.
- f) <u>MUSICAL STALLS</u> Similar to musical chairs, stalls will consist of poles laid on the ground.
- g) <u>EQUITATION</u> English or Western, will be judged according to the style of riding and the breed standard.
- h) <u>ON COMMAND</u> All ages. Instruction will be given before the class starts.

#### 10. PRIZES

- a) Rosettes to 6<sup>th</sup> place will be awarded
- b) Top Long Ear will be awarded in designated classes for the driving show and open show (see class lists)\*\*
- c) Championship buckles will be awarded to Top Driving Long Ears, Top Youth Handler, Top Ridden Long Ears, and Top Overall Long Ears. Points accrued based on class placings.
