Activities start at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday**

Start your driving season (or career) off with an informal event that will give you the opportunity to practice using elements of a carriage driving competition purely at your own discretion and pace in a non-competitive situation. What's available?

- Self stabling – we will have horse water available.
- Working with your equine with other equines and vehicles around. This includes ground driving if you prefer, or hitched to your vehicle.
- Driven dressage – will have references for the ACDA – recommended pattern for 2024.
- Cones Course
- Partial Marathon Section B

Maximum Entries – Entries are accepted on a first come, first served basis and time stamped with payment of the entry fee.

Cost – \$50 for the weekend, or \$35 for one day, either Saturday or Sunday.

Logistics – We have camping spots available for you and your equine. You are responsible for your own meals and beverages, with the exception of the Saturday evening meal. We will have coffee and water available.

Spectators are welcome – If you want to join us for dinner Saturday night, please let us know. The cost will be \$10 per person for spectators and navigators. Dinner is included for one person in the registration fee.



Format

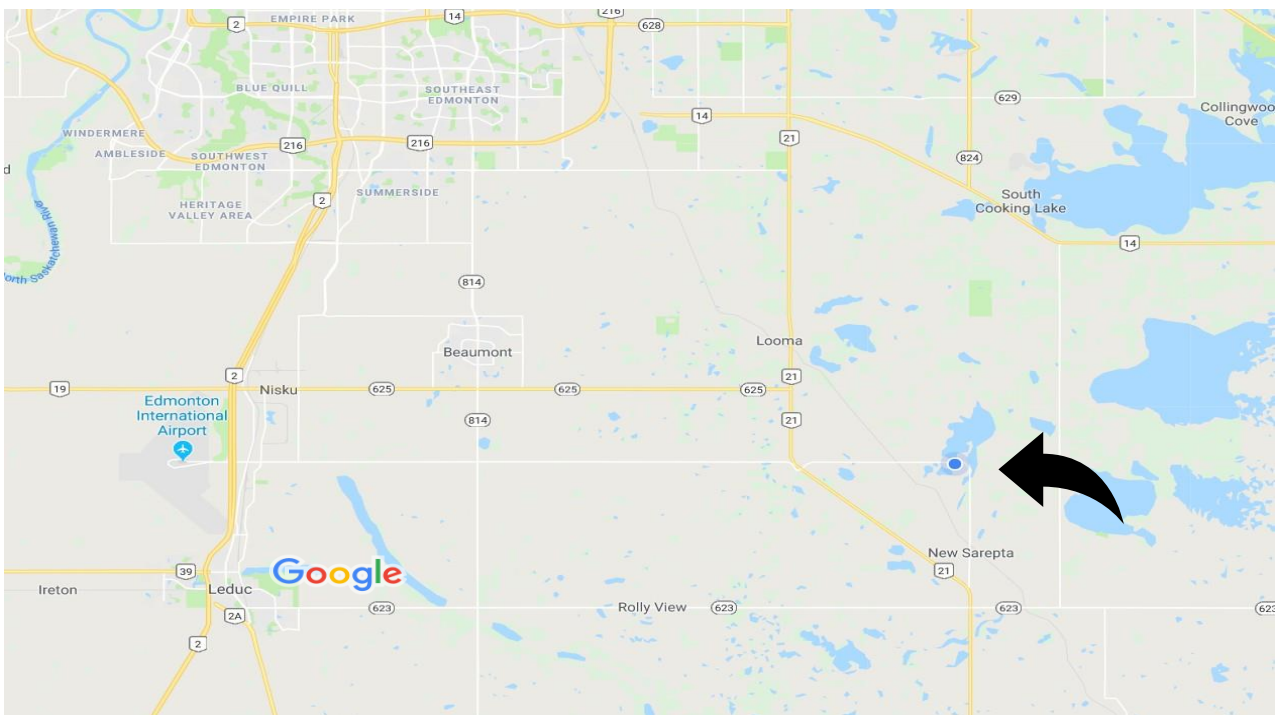
Friday – Arrive, set up your space, visit, and maybe take a drive around the site, or use our square round pen or fenced turf arena.

Saturday – Use our round pen, practicing in the dressage arena, the cones course, and individual obstacles. Alternatively, get some kilometers in on a 5 km (approximate) 5 obstacle version of a Section B marathon course.

Saturday Evening – join us for dinner – we will provide dinner in part, courtesy of one of our local sponsors, Boston Pizza. Join us around the campfire for the evening or relax on your own.

Sunday morning and afternoon have the dressage and cones areas available with the marathon course being replaced by a derby course.

New This Year – Beyond our typical set up with access to a dressage area, cones course and marathon course, we are adding the opportunity to practice on a derby course. We will reset a portion of the marathon course as a derby for participants to use on Sunday. Timers will be available for anyone who wants to track their progress through the derby course.
