Equine First Aid Kit Suggestions

THE "GOLDEN RULE" FOR FIRST AID KITS:

The contents are for emergency use only! When used, they should be immediately replaced!

- > Sturdy Card With Phone Number of Veterinarian
- ➤ List of Normal:
 - o Temperature
 - o Pulse
 - o Respiration
- > Small Note Book with pencil to keep track of TPRs and treatment (keep in a Ziplock)
- Basic Veterinary First Aid Book
- > Flashlight (with extra batteries)
- ➤ Thermometer (preferably flexible, digital)
- > Stethoscope
- Bandage Scissors
- > Tweezers
- ➤ Hoof Pick
- ➤ Hand Sanitizer
- ➤ Latex Gloves
- ➤ 4 X 4 Gauze Sponges (keep all cottons and bandages in sealed Ziplock bags to keep them clean)
- ➤ Non-adhesive Dressings (Telfa)
- ➤ Roll Gauze
- ➤ Gamgee, Sheet Cotton or Quilted Stable Wraps
- > Vetrap
- ➤ Lightplast (Elastic Adhesive Bandage)
- ➤ Paper Towels (or clean towels)
- Disposable Diaper (for foot bandage)
- ➤ Lip Twitch
- Duct Tape
- Clean Bucket
- > PVC Pipe for Splints
- ➤ Pliers or Nippers (to pull nails)
- > Epsom Salts
- > Eye Wash
- ➤ Antiseptic Scrub and Solutions (Betadine or Hibitane) check expiry dates regularly
- ➤ Antibiotic Ointment (Hibitane, Silvadene or Dermagel) check expiry dates regularly
- Antibiotic Wound Spray (Vetericyn) check expiry dates regularly
- ➤ Electrolytes check expiry dates regularly
- Zinc Oxide Cream
